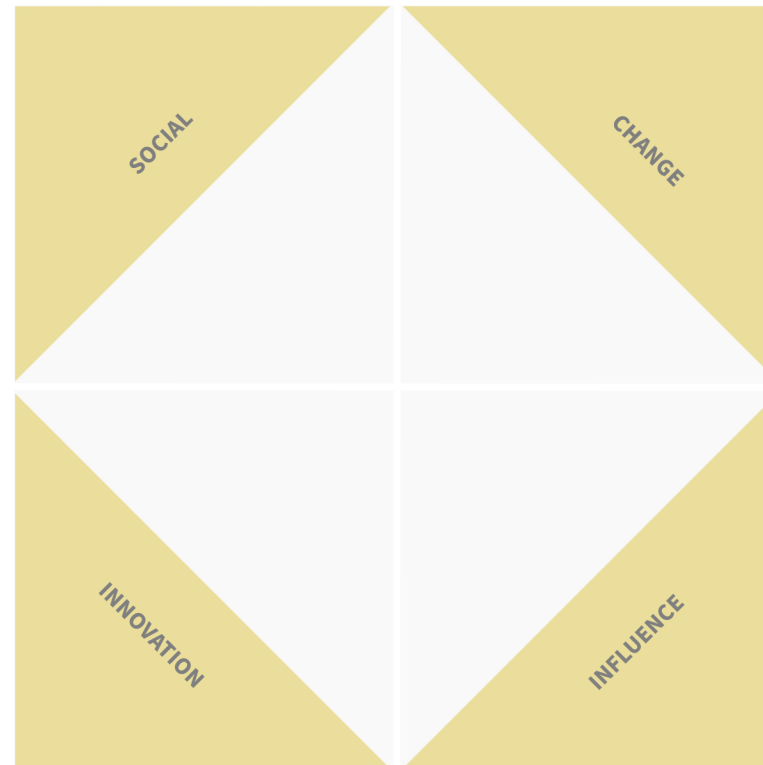
HELLO HUMAN
